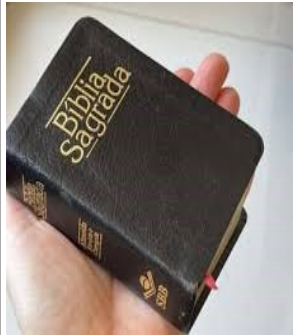


Bibles For Portugal
