Come and join us after the service as we will be fellowshipping at the home of Cory & Lisa Durant.



Mile One Mission was founded to reach the people of the province of Newfoundland and Labrador with the gospel of Jesus Christ through the planting of churches.

Currently there are less

than 1% of the population that attend any type of evangelical church. They currently have two church plants in St. John's: Downtown Community Church and Route 10 Community Church (formerly the Kilbride Community Church) and one church plant in Happy Valley-Goose Bay—Northern Cross Community Church. Pray for them as they look to initiate Phase II of the church planting mission.

Please be in praver for the following:

Northern Cross Community Church: Pray for John Lewis as he seeks to establish trust with the Indigenous communities and that he will have doors of opportunity opened for sharing the gospel. The area has a population of 9,000–45% are Anglo, 45% Indigenous and 10% Filipino.

Downtown Community Church: Pray for Adam (and Sabrina) Diamond as he shepherds this congregation. Pray for opportunities to reach into this broken community. There are approximately 10,000 people with no local evangelical church. Pray for stability as they have had to move their place of meeting as they were no longer able to meet in the Community Centre.

Route 10 Community Church: Pray for Matthew and Ruth Lahey as they have found a permanent place for them to hold their church services. Pray for them as they work through different what different ministry opportunities might look like in their community.
